As 2016 draws to a close I am pleased to present to you the full 2017 catalogue of SEACEN training courses. In total we are offering twenty-five courses to our member Central Banks and Monetary Authorities. This includes seven SEACEN signature programs that are designed to bring cutting edge insights and techniques to the attention of the participants. Subject to the usual cost-sharing arrangement, the training courses are also open to our Associate Members and Observers.

The training courses cover:

- Macroeconomic and Monetary Policy Management (MMPM): 8 courses of which two are joint with the Financial Stability and Supervision pillar
- Financial Stability and Supervision (FSS), 12 courses of which two are joint with MMPM
- Payments and Settlement Systems (PSS), 3 courses
- Leadership: 3 courses
- Governance: 1 course

In MMPM, we have added one course on modelling and forecasting while retaining the other courses from the successful 2016 programs. In FSS, we are adding a course on technology risk which is becoming an increasingly important issue for banks and supervisors. The courses on Leadership have undergone a transformation, and I am confident that your staff will find them highly enriching.

As in previous years, the resource persons for the courses will be drawn from SEACEN's own expert staff as well as from our world-class strategic partners. We have already secured participation from the Bank for International Settlements, the Financial Stability Institute, and the International Monetary Fund, and we also expect to engage specialists from our Members, leading financial industry institutions such as SWIFT and the Institute for International Finance, as well as leadership development specialists from institutions such as ICLIF and Human Capital Group Asia.

The courses have been designed and customized based on the learning needs of our members. The detailed course agenda will be provided well in advance of each course, but we are giving you ample opportunity to indicate your Institution's interest in particular courses to secure places for your staff. We look forward to the active participation of your staff.

I wish you and your staff happy holidays and a productive and prosperous 2017.
